FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Offer the Grit Pecking Block free-choice to all classes of poultry. Place blocks on the ground in a dry area, away from where flock receives its staple food supply. This block is intended to support natural pecking behavior and provide free-choice grit. Its not a replacement for any nutritional supplementation or feeding program. Grit Pecking Block will aid in reducing aggressive pecking behavior, lower stress, reduce boredom in the coop, and facilitate proper digestion of feed.
